Saab to demonstrate defence innovations at ADEX 2023

Saab, a leading defence and security company, is set to showcase a range of the advanced solutions and technological prowess at Seoul ADEX 2023, which takes place at Seoul Airport, Korea from 17 to 22 October, at booth C505.

The product offerings Saab will display at the show represent decades of innovation, including GlobalEye a multi-domain Airborne Early Warning & Control (AEW&C) solution; state-of-the-art electronic warfare solutions; the Giraffe 1X compact high-performance lightweight 3D radar; ground combat systems such as Carl-Gustaf® M4, AT4, and NLAW; training & simulation offerings; and the AUV62-AT anti-submarine warfare training system.

As a highlight, Saab will be displaying GlobalEye - a solution that is a product of Saab's long heritage in AEW&C with a history of more than 30 years. GlobalEye is the most modern and capable airborne surveillance solution available on the market today. With its mix of modern active and passive sensors, it provides long-range early detection and identification of objects in the air, at sea and over land from a single platform.
